LUCKY PLAYER prompted the pace two wide, forged a narrow lead entering the stretch, was headed by his stable mate with a furlong to run, brushed with that one in the drive, but fought back valiantly to prevail. BOLD CONQUEST settled in hand, made a bold bid circling five wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, brushed with the determined LUCKY PLAYER in the drive and grudgingly gave in. HASHTAG BOURBON attended the pace along the inside, was hemmed in through the second turn to the final furlong, altered course to the outside but was left with too much to do. DANNY BOY settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch to make a his bid five wide, was floated out further in the drive when HASHTAG BOURBON came out looking for room and went evenly late. MR. Z set the pace along the inside through the second turn and tired. CLEVELAND SOUND tracked the pace four wide, ranged up between rivals to make his bid with a quarter to run, was bottled up between horses, steadied entering the stretch and came up empty in the drive. HOLY FRAZIER saved ground to no avail. DEKABRIST was fractious in the gate, contended along the inside, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. THE GORILLA MAN was never a factor.
