Non-winners of \$55,000 allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than claiming, 4 lbs.; one race other than claiming, 6 lbs. x by the closing time of entries. (Clear 85)

Bay Colt, (Apr), by Eddington - Ragtime Hope by Dixieland Band. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Willmott Stables(KY). SECRET CIRCLE had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away, was ridden along to widen past the furlong marker while drifting in and was under a long hold late. GALEX drifted in at the gap, chased inside, came out leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and gained the place late. PANETTONE settled a bit off the rail, swung out leaving the turn and into the stretch, split horses a sixteenth out and bested the others. A TOE BY THREE drifted in at the gap and was straightened, dueled inside, gained the advantage on the turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SWEET SWAP dueled three deep early then outside a rival, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened. SCALLION dwelt to be away well behind the field, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun.
