Bay Gelding, (Apr), by Artie Schiller - The Green Owl by Carson City. Trainer Robertson McLean. Bred by John T. Crane Jr & Margaret M. Crane(MD).

SLIP AND DRIVE cleared early and secured the inside, was joined into the backstretch by SUPER CHUNKY, dueled, was headed after six furlongs, battled back to regain command in upper stretch while in the two path, briefly shook clear in mid stretch, was joined from the rail by ROADHOG inside the sixteenth marker and dug in gamely under stout handling to narrowly prevail. ROADHOG was checked off heels around the first turn, recovered and rated while saving ground off the pace, awaited room around the final turn, got through along inside when SLIP AND DRIVE came off the inside in upper stretch, rallied inside of that one leaving the sixteenth marker, battled gamely and just missed. SUPER CHUNKY prompted the pace outside of the winner, moved to engage into the far turn, dueled and gained a slim lead after six furlongs, drifted outward a couple of times in the lane but stayed on well. PARIS VEGAS rated forwardly two wide just off the dueling leaders, had ample room to go through when under a ride past the three sixteenths marker but failed to seriously kick on. LONDON LANE settled off the rail, advanced four wide nearing the quarter pole, shifted out wider in the drive but could only muster a mild rally. AIR SUPPORT was steadied back from between runners soon after the start, was taken well in hand soon after and saved some ground, angled out leaving the far turn, swung well out in the track for the drive and steadily closed the gap. RIDING THE RIVER stalked the pace three wide, came four wide for the drive and went evenly. UTLEY, between foes a long way, failed to rally. DANNHAUSER, reluctant to load, raced removed from the rail and failed to menace. SNEAKY KITTEN, three wide, made a slight run between rivals into the stretch, failed to go on and faded.
