TONALIST was unhurried while off the inside during the initial stages, was one of many having its rider take hold and tipping outward to avoid the fallen rider in the vicinity of the half mile pole, worked out a tuck along the rail and took a respite there before angling back into the two path at the five-sixteenths pole, was forced to remain oh hold, idling behind a pair for the majority of the way through the furlong grounds, altered course towards a usable opening and after being given his cue, split rivals past the furlong marker while advancing towards the lead with good speed and momentum, wrested away the advantage in the final seventy yards and kicked away. ZIVO settled along the inside route shortly after the start, vacated it only long left to get steadied and safely moved past a prostrate jockey as three-quarters was being completed, left the rail permanently at the five-sixteenths pole by getting angled outward, ended up in the four path by the conclusion of the move, finished willingly to garner the place. LONG RIVER was quickly placed along the inside, sat forwardly placed, was forced to steady after being bumped by a stumbling opponent near the nine-sixteenths pole, was angled three wide entering the turn and scurried into contention during the rest of the way to the quarter pole, loomed boldly at that station, got set down and forged his way to a slim advantage, got collared with about seventy yards remaining and weakened into the show slot. MORENO was put to a firm hold by the rider and allowed to stalk BIG CAZANOVA in the initial stages, angled sharply over into the two path approaching the end of the backstretch, cut off WICKED STRONG, got clipped from behind by that opponent, pressed the issue for the next quarter, issued an abbreviated challenge for command turning for home, wasn't up to the task at hand and backed away. STEPHANOATSEE stumbled outward at the start, bumping soundly with V.E.DAY, raced three wide around both turns, got steadied after the incident at the half mile pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. V. E. DAY bumped solidly at the start, raced from off the inside throughout, was steadied and placed into the five path near the half mile, one of many steering around the vulnerable pilot lying on the track at that juncture, gradually worked his way back into the two path and towards the front runners, spun four wide into the stretch under strong encouragement, flattened out. LAST GUNFIGHTER brushed at the start, raced along the outside, had the rider take hold, while getting gently placed along the overland near the beginning of the far turn, was forced back onto the same route at the three-eighths pole, entered the stretch and had no offering. BIG CAZANOVA (ARG) made a three wide run to grab the advantage, was guided over to the rail after having secured it, got overhauled coming to the quarter pole, turned for home with the rider applying a protective hold and retreated. SPEAK LOGISTICS took up the chase from the two path, undertook the task put to a drive from the half mile pole to midway on the second bend, was taken hold and tipped outward to allow an escape route toward the outside for the rider-less rival, remained under a firm hold never recovering interest. MICROMANAGE was bumped twice after bobbling at the start, swung three wide into the backstretch, was one of plethora of horses forced to check and steady after the spill near the half mile pole, was through after going a mile and got eased. WICKED STRONG took up position in the middle of the field towards the two path, appeared to act a bit keen at times travelling down the backstretch, got impeded by MORENO in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths marker, stumbled after clipping the previously-named opponent's heels, losing the rider as a result. Following a Stewards' Inquiry reviewing the incident at the half mile pole focusing on MORENO, that rival was disqualified from fourth and placed last for causing interference.
