1st MILES. (Turf) (1.46¹) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 JEFFERSON CUP S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over a mile on the turf allowed 21 lbs.; a graded sweepstakes over a mile on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 30, 2009 with 20 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.). (Clear 81)

FLORENTINO (JPN) pulled to the fore to dictate terms, kept on well through a prolonged drive and gamely led throughout. EL CRESPO tracked the pace three deep, continued on willingly through a long drive but was unable to reach the winner. NO INFLATION attended the pace tucked in along the hedge, lacked room entering the stretch, altered course to the outside of FLORENTINO (JPN) inside the furlong marker, but failed to improve his position while in tight quarters. ADVICE was unhurried into stride along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. JAKE WIL GALLOP lunged at the start, angled out to be clear before going a quarter, chased the pace four wide to the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. BRUCE N AUTUMN settled into stride under a snug hold but showed little when asked. HAR D BOY was never a factor.
