EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH advanced inside rivals and went clear leaving the chute, dictated the pace under a light hold, opened up into the far turn, had his rider take a peek back to measure any competition into the lane, straightened two wide into the stretch, responded when asked a furlong out and maintained a comfortable advantage under steady hand encouragement. WILD LOUIS saved ground off the pace, edged up a bit into the lane, moved off the rail for the final furlong and gave game chase to the wire. CONCEALED IDENTITY , three wide between runners nearing the half mile pole, came four wide for the drive and kept on willingly to just nab the show. BELLEFIRE exchanged bumps with TOOTH N CLAW in the initial strides, moved up four wide outside rivals after a quarter mile, dropped in some to give hard pursuit mid turn, failed to kick on and faded in the final furlong. OUTHAUL , wide into the turn, failed to respond. TOOTH N CLAW bumped with BELLEFIRE early, settled well off the early pace, came four wide for the drive, lacked a rally and was trying to get out some in mid stretch. WHO DAT BOY chased between runners early, dropped to the rail around the turn then faltered after six furlongs.
