GIROLAMO broke a bit awkwardly, moved up from outside along the backstretch, settled just behind the leaders for a half, launched a bid from outside on the far turn, closed the gap while three wide to threaten nearing the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch and edged clear under intermittent right hand urging. BURLEY'S GOLD was reserved while saving ground for a half, swung three wide on the turn, raced within striking distance into upper stretch then closed late in the middle of the track while drifting out in the late stages. KENSEI stalked the pace in the two path for a half, took the lead on the far turn, maintained a slim advantage nearing the quarter pole, relinquished the lead to the winner in midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. DENVER trailed along the backstretch, swung three wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. PITCHED PERFECTLY sprinted clear along the rail, set the pace for five furlongs, gave way on the turn and drifted out while tiring at the quarter pole.
