1 MILE. (1.32²) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *JEROME S. (GRADE II)* FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters will receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2012 other than restricted stake allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 5 lbs.; \$39,000; or two races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 7, 2012 with 63 Nominations. (Clear 69)

THE LUMBER GUY away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap went on to secure a forward position well before departing the chute, carved the pace from the inside, under a good hold and under the watchful eye of BRIGAND, parked in the two path and also under a good from his pilot, continued along on nearly the same terms during the run around the bend, except with both riders now gently asking their mounts for a little run, spun into the lane with the runner up still latched on directly to the outside and got set down to a hard drive, slowly but surely edged away from the main competitor making his way from upper to midstretch, extended the winning margin thereafter while kept busy. BRIGAND was rated in the two path while pressing the issue, was let out a notch upon reaching the end of the backstretch and kept pace with the top one, got put to encouragement as the two front runners neared the head of the stretch, fell back steadily making his way through the furlong grounds, held on well enough though to be second best. STIRRED UP tucked along the rail in the opening stages, contently loped along for the initial half, departed the backstretch and began to pick up interest, was angled outward and spun from the four path into the stretch under a full drive, closed well belatedly to secure the show, although no match for the top twosome. DAN AND SHEILA raced along the outside, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to give it. ADIRONDACK KING off the inside initially, was sent over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, took the inside route from that station until upper stretch, had no rally. TERM LOAN settled within range of the front runners soon after the start, rated unkindly for much of the opening half, offering stubborn resistance on the bit, had the rider apply a snug hold down the backstretch without much better results to show for the effort, was given some rein and went about more professionally departing the backstretch, got placed and asked for some run leaving the three-eighths pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch then folded.
