MEADOW BLUE was steadied nearing the clubhouse turn, raced off the pace, moved up four wide on the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch and was just up for third. CARROTS ONLY stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn and lost third on the wire. UPTURN raced off the rail, came three wide into the lane and failed to rally. MY HUSBAND stalked four wide and failed to respond. CALABRIA BELLA saved ground and had no rally. FOUR O WON tracked inside and faded.
