JESS'S DREAM was off the slowest, after appearing to graze the left side of the starting gate, was gradually sent over to the inside, maknig it there before arriving at the conclusion of the homestretch, was slow to settle into stride, at times reaching out greenly, was guided out two to three wide spinning onto the backstretch, remained off the rail all the way to the quarter pole, picked up the pace noticeably after stepping onto the far turn, was on the move outward heading home, with good momentum by this juncture, fanned wider and wider until tin the vicinity of the seven path by the completion of the maneuver which occurred in midlane, all the while chopping away steadily at the deficit, overhauled a pair of rivals with a few jumps to spare before the finish line, crossing it being hand ridden. SECURITIZ kept watch on the pacesetter parked out three wide on both turns, ranged up and challenged in earnest as the field turned for home, forged to the narrowest of leads during the stretch drive, dug in with good detererminatktion only to get collared in the shadow of the finish line. GODREVV bumped lightly with CAPTAIN TIM springing forth from the gate, raced towards the inside for a shade more than three-quarters, came three to four wide into the stretch, finished with late foot en route for show honors. ALL RISE broke alertly and maintained control, set the splits, coaxed while saving ground on a loosely-contested lead, had PRODIGAL latch on shortly after leaving the backstretch, with the runner up adding its presence to the pace picture before the end of the second bend, vied with vigor to defend the advantage, locked in a spirited tussle with SECURITIZ, drifted out a couple of paths at the eighth pole, got put back closer to the rail and thereafter on a straighter route, weakened late, then was vanned off after the finish. CAPTAIN TIM made light contact with GODREVV at the start, took up the chase from the two path, got placed four wide at the top of the lane, lacked the needed response. SHARM loosely pocketed for the opening six furlongs, got roused midway on the far turn, proceeded to get angled outward a sixteeneth later, altered course closer to the rail during the initial portion of the stretch, gave way. PRODIGAL attained a forward position after breaking sharply, stalked the leader from the two path, pulling on the bit for a good portion of the initial half, settled down enough to advance steadily and hitch up to the pacesetter a short distance past the half mile pole, kept up the pressure for the remainder of the way to the quarter pole before tiring.
