Bay Horse, (Jan), by Awesome Again - Lil Punkindo by Maria's Mon. Trainer Nedrick Dalton. Bred by Adena Springs(ON).

WON AWESOME DUDE was guided to the rail in the opening stages to track the first flight from just out of striking distance, steadily gained terms with those foes on the far turn, shifted out four deep nearing upper stretch, then continued with a sustained response to collar R CLEAR VICTORY and edge that rival under brisk handling. The latter, close up three wide in early stages, pressed the issue in that path racing through the far turn, gained a narrow advantage late, resisted the winner's challenge but came up second best. COYOTESHIGHESTCALL, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out to bid between foes after a half, forced the pace to upper stretch but weakened when unable to match terms with the top pair late. SENSATIONAL SCORE was rated along the inside early, shifted off the inside making steady progress on the far turn, was fanned five wide in upper stretch and failed to sustain his momentum. CATMANTOO stumbled badly at the start, was settled for a half, made a brief bid near the inside on the far turn but had nothing further for the drive. STRATOSTAR was allowed to settle near the inside in the opening half and never gained striking distance. STERLING HEAT angled inwards to track the pace outside a rival but never mounted a serious challenge. FIGHT ON was hustled to the lead, dictated the pace to the far turn racing nearest the rail but emptied out abruptly in the drive. CANELA tracked the leaders racing well off the inside for a half and soon dropped out.
