1½ MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *JIM DANDY S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers if there are six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 over a mile in 2011, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Any horse that competes in both the Jim Dandy and the Travers will have their subscription fees waived for the Travers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 16, 2011 with 48 Nominations. (Clear 85)

STAY THIRSTY away in good order, took up the pursuit three wide, accelerated when let out early on the far turn, swept his way into contention, shadowed DOMINUS' closer to the inside once both were safely past the former pacesetter, responded well when fully roused in upper stretch, forged his way to a clear advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, drew away the last eighth, crossing the wire under brisk hand encouragement. MOONSHINE MULLIN contently rode the pocket, was lightly hand urged on the second turn to keep pace with the front runners, slipped off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide for the stretch drive and took off in earnest, closed willingly to out finish DOMINUS for place honors, while never posing a serious threat to the winner. DOMINUS assumed a forward position after leaving the gate, was placed under a firm hold and patiently stalked the leader, parked just off that one's hind quarters, continued along on the same scenario for nearly six furlongs, moved when ready, overhauling an energetically handled WILL'S WILDCAT, completely under his own courage, had no sooner taken charge when confronted by the top one, got called upon in response to that opponent's challenge, failed to keep pace, readily relinquishing, getting out finished for second as well. ALTERNATION unhurried early, swung three wide into the stretch, proved no match. BRILLIANT SPEED underwent a four wide journey and tired. WILL'S WILDCAT came inward, making contact twice with SCOTUS at the start, established control soon afterwards and was guided over to the inside once sufficiently clear, was rated cutting the fractions, with DOMINUS nearby on the outside, making his presence felt, had no answer when that one made his challenge leaving the three-eighths pole, succumbing despite being put to encouragement, tired steadily thereafter. SCOTUS bumped twice leaving the gate, raced along the outside, felt the whip at several points down the backstretch and around the far turn, had no response.
