By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$6,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One at a mile or over in 2016 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two at a mile or over in 2016 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade Three at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 16, 2016 with 22 Nominations. (Cloudy 83)

LAOBAN coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way in hand in the two path through sensible splits uncontested while attended by DESTIN to the outside, settled into a rhythm midway down the backstretch showing the way comfortably, remained patiently handled until put to encouragement nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home roused for the stretch drive under threat from a pair, dug in drifting out slightly nearing the eighth pole before drifting in slightly nearing the sixteenth marker and held sway kept busy to the wire. GOVERNOR MALIBU saved ground near the rear early on, advanced into the moderate pace to be just off the leader to the inside with five eighths to go, came under urging three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch lacking optimal clearance briefly until the eighth pole, got taken out to the two path as the leader drifted in nearing the sixteenth marker and jostled lightly knocking heads to the wire with DESTIN to secure the place honors unable to reel in the top one to the wire. DESTIN three wide through the opening bend, raced forwardly placed three wide in closest aim of the leader, at times briefly latched on to that rival, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, continued three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive threatening tepidly through the stretch, couldn't reel in the eventual winner while dueling through the final sixteenth with GOVERNOR MALIBU and lost that battle while well clear for the show honors. MOHAYMEN stumbled at the start pecking the ground, tracked the pace just off the inside in range of the front in hand until put to prolonged coaxing with half a mile remaining, spun three wide into upper stretch before tipping to the four path and bumping with RACE ME HOME straightened away, then weakened through the final furlong. RACE ME HOME (IRE) three wide through the first turn, raced three wide in pursuit from near the rear of the compact field in hand until put to a ride at the three-eighths, angled four to five wide for home under a drive, got bumped by MOHAYMEN straightened away, weakened through to the finish. CREATOR allowed to settle at the rear of the compact field in the two path, came under prolonged urging with half a mile to run, angled four wide into upper stretch, trailed.
