1 1/4 MILE. (1:463) STAKES. Purse \$600,000 Jim Dandy S. (Grade II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$9,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One at a mile or over in 2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two at a mile or over in 2019 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 13, 2019 with 18 Nominations. (Clear 86)

TAX broke on top and retained a narrow advantage during the journey leading up to the crown of the clubhouse bend, slid over to the rail right after stepping onto it, was taken hold, willing to concede the top to WAR OF WILL as the field headed for the top of the backstretch, tipped into path three after leaving the first turn, was patiently ridden stalking the aforementioned rival, tucked into path two in time for the start of the run around the second bend, was still being held in reserve poking a head in front in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, went onward for another sixteenth, pilot chilly in the saddle, contrasting the rest, all being urged along in varying degrees by this juncture, shifted towards path three when called upon for more himself right around the three-sixteenths pole, edged away, beginning the furlong holding what turned out to be his largest lead, came under pressure from TACITUS to his left late, but dug in gamely to prevail. TACITUS came away the tardiest after stumbling badly at the break, was sighted pulling a bit on the bit finally settling into stride coming up to the conclusion of the homestretch, cut over to the inside, quickened, closing the gap after halfway done with the run on the backstretch, continued to make progress once on the second bend, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole, maintained the momentum tipping into path two at the head of the stretch, split rivals at the furlong grounds, narrowed in with good determination, but was staved off. GLOBAL CAMPAIGN strung out three wide on both turns, was one path wider pursuing the front runners on the backstretch, swung out to path five spinning into the stretch, mustered up a mild kick for the show. LAUGHING FOX stayed along the inside after the start, came under some hand urging prior to the half mile pole, was maneuvered into path four from the top of the far turn to the five-sixteenths pole, left that station being roused, got sent six wide entering the stretch, made no impact. WAR OF WILL remained forwardly placed after an alert getaway, was pulling on the bit launching his way to the front end with a three to two wide run on the first turn, got guided over closer to rail once sufficiently in the clear, thereafter showing the way, spaced at a slight distance from off it, relinquished despite getting called upon in the general area of the five-sixteenths pole, hung around as a prominent factor until the furlong grounds before backing away. MIHOS well rated early, went into the five path after vacating the backstretch, becoming the widest of all, was soon called upon, got ridden into path seven during the opening stages of the stretch run, had no rally. Following a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start, the result was allowed to stand and the race was made official.
