By subscription of \$100 each. \$500 to pass the entry box. \$500 additional to start with \$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Unearned guaranteed purse money is split between the horses that start and finish the race. Weights: Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$50,000 in 2012, 4 lbs.; of \$40,000 in 2012, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Sarter races not considered in estimating allowances). Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Proud Citizen - Thorette by Affirmed. Trainer Weaver George. Bred by Fiddlers Green Stable, LP(NY). FIDDLERS PATRIOT , forwardly placed outside JU JITSU JAX, overtook that one in upper stretch then drew out while kept under urging. SUPER CHUNKY bobbed leaving the starting gate, advanced in the two path on the turn and continued nicely through the stretch to gain the place. JU JITSU JAX sped to the front, angled to the rail leaving the backstretch, saved ground setting the pace and gradually weakened the final furlong. CACTUS SON came in leaving the starting gate, steadied in close quarters inside horses leaving the backstretch, eased out to the three path leaving the turn and rallied between horses. BEN'S CAT lacked speed, was in the three path leaving the turn, worked between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. REGAL REVENGE , bumped by CACTUS SON leaving the starting gate, was well back early, saved ground and passed tired foes late. DISCO DANDY , steadied in close quarters near the half mile pole, circled the turn three wide, chased the pace to the stretch then weakened. ZEB , very wide leaving the turn, was outrun. RICKY'S LITE , four wide turning for home, weakened. AWAKINO CAT , steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch, entered the stretch in the two path and weakened.
