MOKAT chased inside then between horses on the second turn, found the rail again into the stretch, bid inside, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and fought back inside the winner late. SUTTON'S SMILE angled in and settled outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a foe for the show. MIRAGE (IRE) also angled in and settled outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, steadied in tight off heels a quarter mile out, was in tight when boxed in passing midstretch and was edged for third. SHEEZA MILKY WAY angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, waited off heels midway on the second turn, came out for room into the stretch and was outfinished along the rail. CORPS DE BALLET had speed between rivals then angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, fought back on the second turn, came out into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and weakened late. JEREMY'S LEGACY (IRE) a bit slow to begin, pulled between foes then dueled outside a rival, stalked on the backstretch, re-bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and also weakened late. OPTIMISM AND HOPE (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, went between rivals on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WAKE THE DAWN angled in and settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. RIRI had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, came out for room into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in midstretch and weakened. ONE LAST SHOT chased outside a rival, continued between horses on the second turn, steadied in tight between foes a quarter mile out, came three wide into the stretch and also weakened.
