Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Mar), by Scat Daddy - Randie's Legend by Benchmark. Trainer George Weaver. Bred by HnR Nothhaft Horseracing LLC (PA).

DADDY IS A LEGEND pulled along the inside chasing the pace, tugged her way up along the rail and steadied into the second turn and again midway on that bend, came out leaving that turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. DATA DEPENDENT chased three deep then outside a rival, went up four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted in but moved up in the drive, bid between foes in deep stretch and edged a rival for the place. RAUCOUS stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, took a short lead outside a rival in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and held third. LEXINGTON GRACE (IRE) saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and finished with some interest. EVER SO TRUE chased between foes then outside a rival or just off the rail, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. CASINO RED (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. MULTIPLAYER angled in and chased a bit off the rail then between foes on the backstretch and second turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. FATALE BERE (FR) a bit slow to begin, went up four wide then three deep on the first turn, took the lead outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SAPPHO (IRE) between horses early, chased three deep to the stretch and did not rally. DEEP BREATH (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled between horses then outside a rival to the stretch and lacked the needed response. THEWAYIAM (FR) stalked three deep then outside a rival, bid three wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. JUST A SMIDGE pulled her way to the early lead and angled in, surrendered the advantage on the backstretch, stalked the leader, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened.
