MAIN SEQUENCE broke awkwardly at the start then lost his lane to REAL SOLUTION who broke outwards at the start, crossed to the inside into the first turn, settled two to three wide down the backside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide into upper stretch, rallied with a good kick to be the outermost of a trio spread across the track just inside the eighth pole, took over narrowly a sixteenth from home under an off sided stick, came in late knocking heads with TWILIGHT ECLIPSE and bumped solidly with that foe strides from the wire as that foe came out under a near sided stick and got the decision by a measured neck. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE tracked the pace along the inside forwardly placed, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, angled out to the two path straightened away, rallied between foes and split them getting carried slightly out by IMAGINING and pinching back the weakening REAL SOLUTION a furlong from home against MAIN SEQUENCE, displaced the leader in tandem with the aforementioned foe a sixteenth from home, knocked heads coming under a near sided stick and came out late to look his foe in the eye, his main rival having the same thought came in, bumped solidly steps from the wire and missed on the line. IMAGINING cut the pace in hand inside, cut the corner into upper stretch, came under urging at the three-sixteenths as the pressure in behind intensified, drifted out slightly forcing TWILIGHT ECLIPSE to cut the seam of the weakening REAL SOLUTION in half a furlong out, dug in under challenge from a pair and was headed a sixteenth from home, kept on readily for the show. BIG BLUE KITTEN reserved two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the half mile pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. HANGOVER KID just off the inside at the rear, got put to encouragement nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home, offered up a mild bid but made no impact. REAL SOLUTION broke out at the start and was corrected, attended the pace from just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, fought on to the furlong grounds now between foes, was in the midst of weakening when pinched between rivals due to pressure from IMAGINING drifting out slightly and weakened through to the wire. MEDAL COUNT three wide through the first turn, remained three wide in range of the front early on, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, retreated through to the quarter pole, spun four wide into upper stretch and tired. There was a Stewards' Inquiry as well as a Jockey's objection by the rider of TWILIGHT ECLIPSE alleging interference against MAIN SEQUENCE steps from the wire that was focused on prior to the race being declared official.
