PROMISES FULFILLED broke on top and retained the advantage, cleared over to the rail soon aftewards, set the splits accompanied by the runner up from the outside, saw KILLYBEGS CAPTAIN add himself to the pace picture as the half was being completed, went into the three path when set down to a hard drive spinning into the lane, shook free, kept busy to the end. WARRIOR'S CLUB pressed the issue two to three wide, was forced to go about the task from between rivals beginning from the three-eighths pole, got turned loose heading home, altered course closer to the rail once the winner had taken up residence in the three path by the three-sixteenths pole, steadily fell back from that one, battled onward matched up KILLYBEGS CAPTAIN in the last eighth and went on to best that one for place honors. KILLYBEGS CAPTAIN stumbled badly springing from the starting gate, then was steadied after making light contact with BON RAISON right afterwards, responded when placed to light hand encouragement and rushed up into a forward postion, departed the backstretch from the three path, ranged up, joining the pace dispute by the three eighths pole, vied for command as the widest of a threesome until the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, got engaged in a duel with WARRIOR'S CLUB for second once the winner began to assert himself, mustered up willingness but fell short of second. NICODEMUS quickly spotted along the inside route, remained on it in pursuit of the front runners, got set down a short distance from the quarter pole, made no headway, then was vanned off after the finish. BON RAISON brushed at the start, took up the chase four wide, doing so as the widest of all, swung about wide into the stretch and gave way. DO SHARE worked out at tuck into the two path before leaving the backstretch, went one path farther off the rail heading into the stretch, failed to fire appreciably. NEW YORK CENTRAL kept watch on the contested pace from the pocket, was called upon for more at the five-sixteenths marker, cut the corner into the lane, lacked a response and backed away.
