By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$100,000 guaranteed. The Owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. EXE reserved while racing three wide, eased out leaving the turn, rallied to reach the leaders, then dueled with AMERIBELLE to the wire and prevailed. AMERIBELLE reserved racing along the inside, angled out and rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole while dueling with EXE but was outgamed to the wire. CUMANA reserved while saving ground, eased out in the stretch and closed to gain the show. HOT CHILI PEPPER chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead three wide on the far turn, contested the pace to inside the eighth pole, then was weakening when steadied at the sixteenth pole. BLACK RUSSIAN allowed to settle after breaking in the air, raced four wide and passed tired rivals in the drive. R BROWN SUGAR moved up to engage OILGONEWILE on the backstretch, vied for the lead along the hedge to inside the eighth pole, then was tiring when caught in tight at the sixteenth pole. PRINCESS TOWN outrun early, improved her position without threatening. BRAZILIANBOMBSHELL steadied in traffic on the first turn and failed to menace. AUGUST RUSH tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and gave way. OILGONEWILE vied for the lead outside R BROWN SUGAR to the top of the stretch, then faltered. NEVER LIE was not a factor. MARIJA'S WISH was through after a half mile.
