1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *JUST A GAME S.(GRADE 1)* FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$400 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to pass the entry box; \$2,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three-year-olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice on the turf in 2007-08 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; A Grade 1 in 2007-08 or a Grade 2 in 2008, 51 bs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted races not considered in allowances). The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 24, 2008 with 23 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 90)

VENTURA was hard early in the early stages, steadied along the inside at the half mile pole, was rated just off the pace to the turn, rallied along the rail to take the lead in upper stretch and edged clear under steady right hand encouragement. LADY OF VENICE (FR) broke slowly, steadied along the inside on the backstretch, moved out on the far turn, raced in traffic while between horses nearing the quarter pole, angled to the inside in upper stretch and finished strongly to gain the place. FOREVER TOGETHER was outrun in the two path for a half, steadied briefly in traffic on the turn, moved out entering the stretch, angled back in at the three-sixteenths pole then rallied belatedly to gain a share. BAYOU'S LASSIE sprinted clear along the inside, led to the top of the stretch then weakened under pressure through the final eighth. SHARP SUSAN pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch and gradually tired thereafter. BIT OF WHIMSY raced well back for a half, circled six wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. CRIMINOLOGIST steadied between horses at the half mile pole, raced in traffic between horses while rallying on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch then flattened out. VACARE stalked the pace four wide for six furlongs and gave way in the stretch. SPENDITALLBABY raced in traffic along the inside while saving ground to the turn and lacked a further response. THEM THERE EYES never reached contention while wide throughout.
