Gray or Roan Mare, (F&B), by Mastercraftsman (IRE) - Anabasis (GER) by High Chaparral (IRE). Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Gestut Karlshof (GER).

A RAVING BEAUTY (GER) a bit fractious in behind the gate prior to loading, chased four then three wide down the backstretch from just off the pace, came under coaxing tucked just off the inside three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to take command a furlong out, then inched away to the finish drifting out in the final strides to the wire. PROCTOR'S LEDGE broke out at the start coming together with CAMBODIA lightly, tracked the pace from just off the inside in mid pack, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung just off the inside into upper stretch before tipping out three wide straightened away and kicked on willingly to secure the place honors in the final strides. LULL bobbed at the start and came under light coaxing to establish the front shortly after the break, showed the way rated on the pace just off the inside, settled into a comfortable rhythm through moderate splits under little direct pressure, remained in the two path through the turn patiently handled until coming under growing threat nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home set down for the drive, inched away briefly into upper stretch, dug in and was headed a furlong out, ran on battling to the wire to preserve the show honors in a blanket finish at the end. OFF LIMITS (IRE) three to four wide in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled six to seven wide at the quarter pole, kicked on belatedly to procure the last major share. ON LEAVE two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, tucked to the hedge half a mile from home, came under a ride at the three-eighths, angled out four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to close in late but was outfinished. DREAM DANCING tracked the front from just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, got pushed along three furlongs out, spun just off the inside at the quarter pole, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. CAMBODIA bumped at the start by PROCTOR'S LEDGE, raced three to four wide down the backstretch in mid pack before chasing two to three wide through the turn under coaxing from midway, angled six wide at the top of the stretch, offered no response. LA CORONEL broke out at the start and was corrected, ranged up shortly after the start out of the dog tailed chute into the backstretch and grew briefly keen under the restriction of the rider before settling with six and a half furlongs to run, raced four then three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under light coaxing half a mile out, applied brief pressure through the turn, swung three wide into upper stretch beginning to back away and weakened through to the finish.
