All Fillies allowed 3 lbs. \$5,000 to pre-enter, \$10,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$500,000 purse including nominator awards of which 54% to the owner of the winner, 18% to second, 9.9% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth; plus stallion nominator awards of 3% to the winner, 1% to second and 0.55% to third and foal nominator awards of 3% to the winner, 1% to second and 0.55% to third. SECRET CIRCLE bumped soundly with **SHUMOOS** leaving the gate, quickly recovered and forced a sharp pace in about the two path, dueled with a slim advantage mid turn, shook clear of **TRINNIBERG** in upper stretch, widened his margin with a furlong remaining, wandered out towards the center of the track near the sixteenth pole, was guided back down and held sway. **SHUMOOS**, bumped with the winner and was squeezed back, dropped well off the pace through the opening quarter while removed from the rail, angled towards the inside when finding his stride a quarter mile out, briefly angled to about the three path, shifted back in for a clear run inside rivals and closed strongly. **HOLDIN BULLETS** stalked a contested pace while three wide, came under urging mid turn, chased the pace into the stretch but went evenly through the final furlong. **SEEKER**, drifted out soon after the break, saved ground while not far back, worked his way outward to about the five path leaving the three sixteenths marker then had a belated response. **JAKE MO**, hopped at the break to be away slowly, was outrun early, angled out very wide for the drive but failed to generate a substantial rally. **SUM OF THE PARTS** bore out into **BLACKY THE BULL** at the break, was sent up between rivals soon after, gained a forward position nearing the turn, tracked the dueling leaders while saving ground around the turn, eased out in upper stretch, came up empty and brushed with **TRINNIBERG** in mid stretch. **TRINNIBERG** came out the break, was righted and grabbed command soon after, set a quick but pressured pace towards the inside, dueled inside the winner from the three eighths pole to the quarter pole, tired in upper stretch then drifted out and brushed **SUM OF THE PARTS** a furlong out. **BLACKY THE BULL**, bumped and forced out at the break, raced well back early, saved ground around the turn but failed to recover. **VEXOR** bore out at the break, was corrected soon after, chased the leaders while four wide, remained a presence for a half then tired.
