Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by High Chaparral (IRE) - Desert Classic (GB) by Green Desert. Trainer O'Brien P. Aidan. Bred by Speers Bloodstock Ltd(IRE).

WROTE (IRE) settled in hand toward the hedge, worked his way forward between rivals through the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch, reeled in the determined EXCAPER and edged clear. EXCAPER tracked the pace three wide, forged to command with a furlong to run, fought on gamely but was unable to resist the winner. FARRAAJ (IRE) attended the pace along the inside, split horses leaving the second turn, got through along the hedge entering the stretch, drew even but flattened in the final yards. LUCKY CHAPPY (IRE) broke slow, was unhurried into stride, wheeled out six wide and was making up ground. ANIMAL SPIRITS tucked in to save ground, moved up through the second turn, was bumped near the three-sixteenths pole, recovered quickly, shifted out and improved position between rivals. DADDY NOSE BEST fought restraint between horses through the first turn, leveled into stride on the backstretch, came four wide to make his bid between horses, was caught in tight and bumped with FINALE late and flattened out. FINALE settled in hand, closed the gap five wide, was floated out further with a quarter to run, angled back toward the inside entering the stretch, was put in tight when LUCKY CHAPPY (IRE) came in, bumped with DADDY NOSE BEST, checked hard and lost his best chance. CASPAR NETSCHER (GB) settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally between rivals. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH was unhurried into stride, came six wide and finished with a belated gain. FANTASTIC SONG was allowed to settle, moved out four wide entering the stretch and finished with some late run. COALPORT was allowed to settle off of the inside between horses, was jostled entering the stretch and was never a factor. STATE OF PLAY was bumped at the start, recovered the lost ground between horses, stayed on to the final furlongs and faltered. MAJESTIC CITY opened clear to set the pace, was collared after five furlong and gave way readily once headed. TEQUILA FACTOR bobbed and bumped with STATE OF PLAY at the start, rushed to contention five wide but stopped after six furlong and dropped out.
