MY SUMMER SLEW steered off the rail early then moved up to pressure the pacesetter, prompted pace outside that rival, whittled gap in the drive, challenged then gained lead inside sixteenth marker and inched despite drifting out late. STONESIDE (IRE) stalked from the inside, continued to hug the rail, came out bit into the lane, loomed between horses in the drive and was up in final strides for second. UNZIP ME broke very sharply and sprinted to the front while angling over, set pressured pace from the inside, battled gamely when challenged inside eighth marker but yielded ground late then lost place in final strides. SCENIC BLAST (AUS) unhurried from well off the rail, chased three then four wide into and around the turn, came out further in the drive and finished well from the far outside. NOBLE COURT settled off the rail, tracked leaders while three wide then outside foe on the turn, came between horses into the stretch and went evenly to the wire. CAYAMBE settled inside, was in bit tight on the backstretch, came off the fence, chased two wide and failed to reach contention from the inside. KELLY LEAK reserved from off the fence, caught four wide into the turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled out some in the drive and failed to menace.
