BAYEUX angled in and settled off the pace alongside a rival, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly three deep on the wire. SILENT NAME (JPN) pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter into the second turn and put a head in front, dueled alongside that rival, inched away and drifted in a bit in midstretch, fought back toward the inside in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. PORTO SANTO (FR) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and finished with interest. MILK IT MICK (GB) pulled his way along outside a rival then stalked inside, waited briefly leaving the second turn, bid along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. AFTER MARKET bumped at the start, chased alongside a foe, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick.
