Gray or Roan Colt, (May), by Kipling - Klondike Kaytie by Encino. Trainer Dutrow, Jr. E. Richard. Bred by Center Hills Farm(OK). KIP DEVILLE bumped at the start, pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, ranged up three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and held gamely between foes late. BAYEUX angled in and settled off the pace alongside a rival, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly three deep on the wire. SILENT NAME (JPN) pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter into the second turn and put a head in front, dueled alongside that rival, inched away and drifted in a bit in midstretch, fought back toward the inside in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. PORTO SANTO (FR) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and finished with interest. MILK IT MICK (GB) pulled his way along outside a rival then stalked inside, waited briefly leaving the second turn, bid along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. AFTER MARKET bumped at the start, chased alongside a foe, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. CHARMO (FR) pulled a bit early, chased along the inside, remained toward the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. THREE VALLEYS allowed to settle outside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BOULE D'OR (IRE) broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled alongside a foe, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. FAST PARADE pulled his way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch, steadied between horses in midstretch and weakened. TERROPLANE (FR) unhurried a bit off the rail early, came out into the stretch and did not rally. GRAFTON saved ground off the pace, remained inside on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
