THE BIG BEAST broke out at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside then four wide on the turn, came under urging with three furlongs to run, was floated five wide into the stretch, pursued the runner-up, came under a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, chased determinedly into the final sixteenth and got up late under strong handling. FAST ANNA leaned out and brushed the gate at the start, showed good speed and went to the front, set the clear pace through reasonable fractions, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, responded well when asked for his best in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, led until the final few strides but was denied. COUP DE GRACE settled on the outside, dropped in inside the five-eighths pole, tugged on the bit leaving the backstretch, went three wide while under some restraint on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, dropped to one off the rail in upper stretch, passed the furlong marker with his head cocked to the outside, moved out behind the top two late and finished willingly for the show. NOBLE MOON angled in towards the rear, settled off the pace, was patiently ridden while in the two path on the turn, came under some urging late on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive, came under a right-handed whip and finished with late energy to improve position but reached his best stride too late. WILDCAT RED hit the outside of the gate at the start and was last away, moved up while urged along then chased the pace, went three wide on the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch, pursued the leader under a right-handed whip into the final furlong and weakened. NOBLE CORNERSTONE was a bit washy during the warm-up, settled off the pace, moved out midway down the backstretch, was urged along while four to five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. MYOSITIS DAN broke out at the start, dropped in near the back, was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, moved out under a drive and was no factor. C. ZEE was rated while off the inside, appeared to dislike the kickback at certain points on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, dropped to the inside in upper stretch, checked sharply at the
