GO BRO stalked the early pace, angled to the outside well before entering the turn, pressed the leaders while racing three-wide, joined the duel heading into the stretch, took a narrow advantage a furlong out, continued to race head-in-head to the wire and prevailed at the finish. HOOTENANNY broke outwards, showed early speed, pressed the leader racing down the backstretch, advanced to commence a duel while racing two-wide on the turn, had a short lead in early stretch, continued to duel hard to the wire and just missed. TOWER OF TEXAS brushed with UNBRIDLED JUAN leaving the gate, was in midpack early racing between horses in a row of four, was at the back on the turn racing three-wide, was carried four-wide turning for home, angled out to a clear outside path at the 3/16ths pole and closed strongly in the final 1/16th. UNBRIDLED JUAN brushed with TOWER OF TEXAS at the start, stalked the early leaders while racing on the inside, continued to stalk from midpack on the turn, was blocked late on the turn and continued to lack room to the 1/8th pole where he angled to the inside and chased gamely to the wire. HOLLYWOOD HIDEAWAY raced between horses from midpack early, was at the back still racing between foes on the turn, angled from two to three-wide turning for home and was in range with the leaders in early stretch but could not match strides in the final yards. DRAGON BAY raced in midpack along the inside, saved ground on the turn racing at the back, stuck to the rail path in the stretch, angled out at the 1/8th pole and finished gamely in vain. IKERRIN ROAD (IRE) broke awkwardly, raced on the outside of the midpack quartet down the backstretch, was four-wide through the turn, advanced to be in range with the leaders in early stretch but flattened out within the furlong pole. SHAKHIMAT got out to set the early pace, dueled while saving ground on the turn, began to gave way at the 3/16ths pole and was empty late. MONSTER BEA broke slowly, trailed the field early, angled to the outside, raced four and five-wide to commence a bid on the turn but failed to threaten.
