All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If there are five (5) or less to start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Bay Colt, (Apr), by Posse - Abbey's Missy by Slewacide. Trainer Von Hemel K. Donnie. Bred by Don C. McNeill(KY).

CALEB'S POSSE was asked from the start, dropped well off the pace while ridden along, raced inside on the turn, moved closer near the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, was put to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, continued to gain on the outside, was switched to a right-handed whip inside the sixteenth-pole and closed powerfully to get up at the wire. UNCLE MO settled on the outside, inched closer while three wide on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, switched to four wide shortly thereafter, rallied on the outside, drifted in while taking the lead in upper stretch, inched clear under a left-handed whip into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. JUSTIN PHILLIP settled off the pace, moved closer while two then three wide on the turn, was asked outside the three-sixteenths pole, moved into a good striking position entering the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. DOMINUS settled off the pace, moved closer while inside on the turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter-pole, was asked outside the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the outside, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed kick. FLASHPOINT was hustled from the start, dueled on the inside, came under the whip in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and tired. POSEIDON'S WARRIOR pressed the dueling leaders on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. RUNFLATOUT dueled on the outside of FLASHPOINT, vied off the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and gave way. COOL BLUE RED HOT was ridden along while well back in the field on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came under the whip nearing the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
