By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$7,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided \$275,000 to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth, \$10,000 to sixth and the remaining \$10,000 to be divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2016, or a Grade 2 twice in 2016 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade 1 or Grade 2 race, 4 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake allowed 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 13, 2016 with 31 Nominations. (Clear 84)

DREFONG away without incident, established the front and crossed inside shortly after the break to show the way through moderate splits in the early going lightly coaxed along three wide, tucked to the two path with half a mile to run, came under more vigorous coaxing five-sixteenths out, cut the corner into upper stretch set down for the drive, drew clear under a drive and held his advantage kept to task to the finish. ECONOMIC MODEL chased the pace along the inside coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly for the place honors. NOHOLDINGBACK BEAR forwardly placed four then three wide in pursuit in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide into upper stretch, drifted out a path under a near sided stick, ran on and just held for the show honors. SUMMER REVOLUTION broke awkwardly at the start, chased just off the inside from just off the pace coming under motivation with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on through the drive for the last major share. MIND YOUR BISCUITS four wide in pursuit from mid pack, got ridden along with three furlongs left to go, angled out five wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick through to the finish. FISH TRAPPE ROAD two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got coaxed along midway on the turn, continued three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. TALE OF S'AVALL broke in at the start and lightly bumped SUMMER REVOLUTION, raced three wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled out seven wide at the top of the stretch, passed tired foes in the drive. BIRD SONG hit the off side stall at the start, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths, cornered three wide at the quarter pole, offered no response. TOM'S READY four wide in pursuit from near the rear, got pushed along with seven-sixteenths to run, angled widest of all eight to nine wide into upper stretch, had TALE OF S'AVALL drift in front a furlong out and steadied very briefly over that foe's heels while offering no response. RATED R SUPERSTAR broke out at the start and made light contact with NOHOLDINGBACKBEAR, chased two to three wide from near the rear, got coaxed along midway on the turn, angled out seven wide for home and never menaced. MOHAYMEN away sharply albeit outwards coaxed from the gate, bumped STAR HILL, chased three wide from mid pack coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, angled six wide into upper stretch, drifted in a furlong out and made no impact. STAR HILL fractious in the gate prior to the start, got bumped at the break by MOHAYMEN who broke a step outwards, chased along the inside under coaxing from three furlongs out, cut the corner into upper stretch, tired, then was vanned off after the finish.
