U D GHETTO close up five wide, moved up in that path and challenged before a half, moved to the fore from the outside entering the stretch then stayed clear while drifting out late. SHERMANESQUE within striking distance three wide, angled out and advanced five wide with less than three furlongs to go, drifted in with a furlong to go when moving closest to the winner, could not threaten that one late but held on well for the place. SON OF THE WEST forwardly placed four wide, stayed on well in that path on the second turn but lacked a late bid while improving his position late. IZZIE'S HALO set the pace off the inside, drifted in with a furlong to go placing NATIVE RULER in tight then weakened. INDIAN CAMP within striking distance early along the inside, came off the rail for the second turn, held on well to the stretch but lacked a closing bid. NERVE pressed the pace three wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. NATIVE RULER reserved along the inside, moved closer on the second turn, steadied in midstretch when IZZIE'S HALO drifted in then tired. BETA CAPO a bit rank when reserved early along the inside, saved ground to the stretch and could not menace. KON KRETE KID unhurried early three wide, was no threat. HEY BILL hit the side of the starting gate door at the start while breaking extremely slowly, circled the majority of the field while five wide on the first turn, reached a challenging position before a half, held on well for six furlongs and tired. OUT OF THE SKIP outrun early, raced four wide on the second turn and was no threat. SHORE steadied late on the first turn from between rivals, angled out, raced five wide on the second turn and was no factor.
