1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (1.42²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *KENTUCKY CUP JUVENILE S.(GRADE III)* FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 26, 2007 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, September 19, 2007 with 39 Nominations. (Clear 75)

Bay Colt, (Jan), by Victory Gallop - Fortyniner Fever by Forty Niner. Trainer Stidham Michael. Bred by Stonerside Stable(KY). TEXAS FEVER pressed the pace four wide, stayed in that path while battling on the second turn, drew clear in midstretch then lasted late. CHITIZ within striking distance five wide, advanced in that path on the second turn, moved to challenge approaching the stretch, dropped back a bit in midstretch then was gaining late and just missed. BLACKBERRY ROAD angled in to race within striking distance while unhurried and along the inside, was patiently handled for six furlongs, steadied when shuffled back entering the stretch, swung to the outside for a clear path and closed fast on the outside. HORSE DOCTOR outrun early three wide, made a bold six wide run leaving the second turn, reached a forward position in upper stretch but hung late. PULASKI RUNNER close up three wide while in hand, raced behind the leaders on the second turn, steadied when in tight and blocked entering the stretch, angled in approaching the furlong marker for room but lacked a closing bid. T. J.'S POSSE reserved early when within striking distance, raced five wide on the second turn, improved his position into the stretch but had no late bid. SHEKINAH unhurried off the rail, raced four wide out of the second turn and had nothing left late. DELAWARE MANOR vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. PONI COLADA prompted the pace three wide, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. CITIZEN JOHN close up along the inside, steadied entering the stretch when in tight then faded in the drive.
