MATTHEWSBURG was unhurried early while six wide, rallied on the turn and took the lead in upper stretch, was under constant handling to the finish. PHILIPPE was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the turn and dueled to upper stretch, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. WILL'S WILDCAT dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. SONG OF HUMOR dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. RONIN DAX showed good early speed while six wide, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. CAL NATION was unhurried early while on the inside, passed tiring rivals and was no threat. CHILLED was void of early speed, was swung nine wide into the stretch and was no threat. LOU BRISSIE was taken up entering the turn, faltered and was no factor. BIG ALBERT was factious in the gate and was eight wide on the turn and had no rally. UNSADDLED GLORY flashed brief speed before stopping. FREE ENTRY was well placed early on the inside, faltered and faded.
