Bay Colt, (Mar), by Maria's Mon - Supercharger by A.P. Indy. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by WinStar Farm, LLC(KY).

SUPER SAVER came in in the initial furlong tightening up inner rivals, was reserved along the inside while within easy striking distance, moved up on his own after six furlongs, rallied between rivals near the quarter mile marker, moved back to the rail when straightened away for the drive, engaged NOBLE'S PROMISE, shook off that one to open a clear lead with a furlong to go then slowly expanded that lead while under steady urging. ICE BOX steadied early in traffic, was outrun for six furlongs, made a bold inside run leaving the three furlong marker, steadied when blocked nearing the stretch, angled out, steadied for a sixteenth of a mile once in the stretch, swung out near the furlong marker for a clear path then closed a late gap to be steadily getting to the winner late. PADDY O'PRADO came in in the early stages forcing STATELY VICTOR into LOOKIN AT LUCKY, was reserved along the inside, followed the winner after a half, came out three wide entering the second turn to split rivals, made a good gain after seven furlongs, swerved out and then back in near the quarter mile marker, split horses soon after, reached closest to the winner with a sixteenth to go but hung. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME pinched back at the start, was far back for five furlongs, angled out entering the second turn for a clear path, made a good run eight wide into the stretch, drifted in once in the stretch and again with a furlong to go then rallied with good courage late. NOBLE'S PROMISE carried into LOOKIN AT LUCKY after the start by the winner, recovered and gained good position between rivals while a bit eager and under a light hold, made a good run off the rail leaving the three furlong marker, split rivals approaching the stretch to take command while well within himself, raced with the winner after straightening away for the drive, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired late. LOOKIN AT LUCKY roughed after the start and again in the initial furlong, was outrun for a half, made a five wide run with less than three furlongs to go, angled in between rivals once in the stretch, maintained momentum to the final furlong then lacked a further bid. DUBLIN outrun for a half, angled out after six furlongs to begin a rally, made a bold run to the quarter mile marker, maintained a good pace to midstretch and tired. STATELY VICTOR bumped with LOOKIN AT LUCKY when forced in in the initial furlong, was outrun for six furlongs moved out five wide into the second turn, made a bold run on that turn while angling in nearing the stretch, reached a striking position with three sixteenths to go but tired thereafter. MISSION IMPAZIBLE shuffled back with a mile to run, recovered, made a good run along the inside on the second turn, came out to split rivals once in the stretch but faded in the final furlong. DEVIL MAY CARE reserved for six furlongs, made a solid five wide middle move while bumping with DISCREETLY MINE approaching the stretch, carried on her move into the stretch, was brushed and carried inward by DUBLIN with a sixteenth to go and tired. AMERICAN LION steadied near the finish line the first turn, was unhurried, made a five wide run on the second turn but failed to respond in the stretch. JACKSON BEND reserved early, made a good middle move, steadied and altered course out approaching the stretch when PADDY O'PRADO swerved out and in then gave way. DISCREETLY MINE came in slightly nearing the first turn tightening up MISSION IMPAZIBLE, raced within striking distance four wide, made a run in that path on the second turn, bumped with DEVIL MAY CARE approaching the stretch and was through soon after. DEAN'S KITTEN in tight at the start, never reached contention. CONVEYANCE sent to the lead and angled to the inside, set a fast pace for seven furlongs, stayed on well to the quarter mile marker, steadied briefly once in the stretch when in a little tight then stopped. HOMEBOYKRIS in tight at the start, raced wide and was outrun while not hard ridden into the stretch. SIDNEY'S CANDY angled in for the run to the first turn, pressed the pace outside CONVEYANCE, held on well for a mile and stopped. LINE OF DAVID close up for a half, stopped. AWESOME ACT in hand early six wide, was never in contention. BACKTALK bumped early, was urged along early and stopped.
