GIRVIN went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths, rallied three then four wide on the far turn, closed strongly to make a bid in upper stretch, drifted in while moving clear at the sixteenth-pole, switched to his inside lead late and proved best under strong urging. **PATCH** bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the far turn, moved to the two path near the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong, was carried in near the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage to get the place. **LOCAL HERO** bumped with an opponent at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced three wide on the far turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, led past the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage to the winner before the furlong marker, was carried in near the sixteenth-pole and weakened while just able to get the show. **HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME** saved ground on the first turn, was reserved near the back, went three then four wide under urging on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. **SORRY ERIK** bumped with **GUEST SUITE** just after the start, raced in the four path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, advanced into a good striking position into upper stretch but flattened out and lacked the needed response. **SENIOR INVESTMENT** traveled around the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, was urged along while inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. **GUEST SUITE** bumped with **SORRY ERIK** just after the start, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the back, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, came under stronger encouragement while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. **HOTFOOT** broke out at the start then was hustled to the lead, crossed over before the first turn, set the clear pace on the inside, was collared at the quarter-pole then gave way. **MONACO** broke out at the start, was taken in hand to allow the rabbit **HOTFOOT** to set the pace, raced in the two path on the first turn, was urged along in second position, passed the half-mile pole under a very strong hand ride, pursued the leader in the two path on the far turn and tired.
