4½ FURLONGS. (.501) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 **LADY CHARLES TOWN S. THE SECOND RUNNING OF LADY CHARLES TOWN.** Fillies Three Years Old. Free nomination, \$250.00 to enter. Nominations close Wednesday, June 10, 2009. Purse will be \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 due at time of entry, all fees included. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$22,000 in 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming in 2009 allowed 6 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four on the alternates list. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, the n highest lifetime earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the owner of the winner. (Clear 83)

JULIET'S SPIRIT forced the leaders from the inside, angled out three wide on the turn, collared the pace setting SCROE ONE MORE in late stretch and drove clear. ONEARMEDBANDIT steadily advanced four wide, was set down for the drive, ducked in mid stretch and steadied off the heels of the winner and finished well. SCORE ONE MORE set the pace along the inside, drew off around the turn, could not resist the winner the last sixteenth. DON'TGETSUSPICIOUS prompted the issue while three wide, held a contending position around the turn but came up empty in the drive. RUNNINGONAPRAYER well placed on the rail, lacked the needed late rally. WILD KAY four and five wide down the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, lacked a closing bid. HOLLYWOOD HILLS pressed the early pace three wide, bore out around the turn to lose all chance. The rider of ONEARMEDBANDIT lodged a claim of foul against the winner alleging interference in the upper stretch. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays but allowed the order of finish to stand.
