MY BEST BROTHER was sent to the early lead and angled in, tugged some and set the pace inside under a rating hold, responded when challenged on the backstretch, kicked clear again on the second turn and held on gamely but was caught on the line. CHIPS ALL IN chased inside, bid between horses then outside the runner-up on the backstretch, stalked just off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch, re-bid between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. BLINGO saved ground chasing the pace, inched forward into the second turn, waited momentarily off heels midway on that turn, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick.
