1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1,394) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LAKE GEORGE S.(GRADE III) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made by time of entries. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races on the turf, 6 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 2 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered for turf and dirt). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that at this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed with Saturday, July 15, 2006 with 39 nominations.

Gray or Roan Filly, (Apr), by Unbridled's Song - Song to Remember by Storm Cat. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by ClassicStar(KY).

MAGNIFICENT SONG angled to the inside while trailing in the early stages, raced well back for six furlongs, launched a rally in traffic midway on the turn, waited briefly for room nearing the quarter pole, angled out entering the stretch then unleashed a strong late run from outside to wear down her entrymate in the late stages. SOMETHINABOUTBETTY sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the front while saving ground, maintained a clear lead to the turn, extended her advantage in midstretch, led into deep stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. QUITE A BRIDE moved up from outside to contest the early pace, pressed the issue along the backstretch, lodged a mild bid from outside leaving the turn then weakened from her early efforts. DIAMOND SPIRIT was caught four wide on the first turn, was unhurried for a half while angling to the inside along the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, rallied mildly along the rail in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. CHRISTMAS STOCKING raced in good position while saving ground, closed the gap along the rail midway on the turn, remained a factor into upper stretch and gradually tired thereafter. PYRAMID LOVE was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, raced between horses for six furlongs, angled four wide on the turn then flattened out. SOUTHERN PROTOCOL raced just off the pace for five furlongs, swung four wide on the turn then faded in the stretch. MOYA raced in the middle of the pack while five wide on both turns and lacked the needed response when called upon.
