1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 LAKE GEORGE S. (GRADE II) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the Lake George and the Lake Placid will have their entry fee waived for the Lake Placid. 122 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races on the turf, 6 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 2 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered for turf and dirt). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 17, 2010 with 51 Nominations. (Cloudy 88)

Bay Filly, (May), by Perfect Soul (IRE) - Lady Shirl by That's a Nice. Trainer Attfield L. Roger. Bred by Charles Fipke(KY).

PERFECT SHIRL away from the gate in good order, bided her time three wide down the backstretch and on the far turn, advanced into a good striking position once past the midway point with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, swung four wide turning for home, took off in earnest when given her cue, closed in relentlessly during the run through the furlong grounds, loomed a serious threat with a furlong to go, then sustaining her momentum, wrestled the lead from EXCLUSIVE LOVE a couple of jumps prior to the wire. EXCLUSIVE LOVE reserved within range three to four wide both turns, moved when ready nearing the top of the stretch, took charge by the time she reached the eighth pole, dug in with good determination with a host of rivals in hot pursuit, yielded reluctantly in deep stretch but continued on gamely to garner place honors. NO EXPLAINING (IRE) took the inside route, remained under a good hold and unhurried for over six furlongs, altered course outward before commencing her stretch bid in upper lane, responded with a good acceleration of speed once called upon, split a narrow opening between rivals at the eighth pole, then maintaining her momentum closed with good courage en route for the show. KHANCORD KID well placed along the inside throughout, loomed boldly with a clear rail pathway at the furlong marker, but lacked the necessary stretch response thereafter. CRESCENDA raced along the outside, and came home willingly. DYNAZAPER forwardly placed for three-sixteenths off the inside, had no rally. NEON LIGHT (GER) raced three wide and failed to reach a contending position. HOUSE OF GRACE was no menace. BAY TO BAY off a beat slowly, raced three wide, swung six wide into the lane, but failed to fire after being set down. CAMINADORA was quickly guided over to the rail after the start, saved ground until the three-sixteenths, angled outward but could muster no kick. GO ASK ALEX rated towards the inside on the lead, wilted after completing six furlongs. STRIKE IT RICH tracked from inside just off the leader, then wilted.
