ANCIENT SECRET settled in hand just off the pace just off the inside behind the cover of GONE AWAY, tipped to the three path nearing the midway point on the far turn placed to light coaxing, advanced through the latter portion of the turn to stack outside the top pair swinging three wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to take over command nearing the eighth pole, inched away under a drive kept to task to the finish. ELYSEA'S WORLD (IRE) settled in reserve just off the inside in mid pack behind the cover of her barn mate ANCIENT SECRET, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung two to three wide at the quarter pole, offered up good energy to chase the aforementioned rival home while safe for the place honors. OUTSIDER ART bumped between foes at the start as each rival flanking her broke her way, settled unhurried two then three wide near the rear getting behind the cover of THUNDERING SKY, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled out four to five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to procure the show honors in the late stages, SKY MY SKY established the front and showed the way crossing to the inside into the first turn and settling into a rhythm in hand while attended to the outside by GONE AWAY but under very little pressure other then that rival's presence, came under coaxing as the eventual winner ranged up to stack three wide with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch under a drive, got displaced near the three-sixteenths and weakened in the late stages. THUNDERING SKY two to three wide in mid pack under rating and in the clear, tipped four wide nearing the three-eighths, continued four wide for home under urging from the five-sixteenths, offered no response. GONE AWAY broke in at the start bumping OUTSIDER ART, crossed to attend the leader from the two path in hand applying very little pressure until nearing the five-sixteenths when between foes for the initial time as the eventual winner stacked to her outside in the three path, spun just off the inside for home between foes under a drive, weakened in the final furlong. BACIAMI PICCOLA (GB) broke out at the start bumping OUTSIDER ART, raced three then two wide through the opening bend settling just off the inside near the rear, took brief cover behind DIAMOND FIELDS, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and made no impact. DIAMOND FIELDS (IRE) tracked the pace along the inside in reserve behind the cover of SKY MY SKY until put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch paused as the saddle appeared to slip forward on his charge near the three-sixteenths putting the rider in a precarious situation, was not persevered with down inside on the rail then had the rider lose the irons inside the sixteenth marker while in hand to
