PROCTOR'S LEDGE just off the pace three wide behind the cover of VICTORY TO VICTORY, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, got set down continuing three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, edged away under a drive kept to task. PARTY BOAT a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, settled three then two wide in mid pack, tipped out four wide carrying DREAM DANCING to the five path midway on the far turn, swung three wide into upper stretch, rallied willingly through the stretch to secure the place honors while chasing the winner home. FIFTY FIVE bumped solidly at the start by FIZZY FRIDAY who broke inwards sharply, settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing shifted to the two path three furlongs from home, angled three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors through the final furlong. CHUBBY STAR established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home under pressure to the outside, cut the corner into upper stretch under threat, got headed nearing the eighth pole and weakened in the late going. FIZZY FRIDAY (GB) broke in sharply at the start bumping FIFTY FIVE solidly, was allowed to settle saving ground near the tail of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung five to six wide into upper stretch, ran on through the stretch. DEFIANT HONOR tracked the pace along the inside patiently handled in behind the cover of CHUBBY STAR, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, lacked room along the inside of CHUBBY STAR briefly when that rival drifted in slightly straightened away and looked to angle out but was unable, had the inside open up and weakened in the late stages. DREAM DANCING three to four wide near the rear, got floated out five wide midway on the far turn by PARTY BOAT, swung four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. VICTORY TO VICTORY three wide through the first turn, raced three wide in aim of the leader before tucking to the two path and advancing on that rival from the three-eighths, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch with dead aim on the leader and came up empty. SUPER MARINA saved ground in mid pack, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. SWEEPING PADDY three then two wide through the opening turn, attended the pace in hand from the two path, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, retreated through the latter portion of the turn, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened.
