1 1/4 MILE. (Turf) (1:38¹) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Lake George S. (Grade III) FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 7, 2018 with 32 Nominations. (Rail at 12 feet). Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Mar), by Scat Daddy - Randie's Legend by Benchmark. Trainer George Weaver. Bred by HnR Nothhaft Horseracing LLC (PA).

DADDY IS A LEGEND brushed the off side stall at the start, settled just off the inside in mid pack, advanced under brief coaxing from the half mile pole to split foes improving position to be just off the pace back under rating midway on the turn, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch forcing the backing away PUNKED to check off her heels sharply, dug in knocking heads with ALTEA straightened away, took over command just inside the eighth pole and inched away to the finish kept to task. ALTEA (FR) three wide into the first turn, tucked to the two path before entering the backstretch settling at the tail of the field, came under coaxing tipped out four wide three furlongs from home and advanced powerfully into contention swinging four then three wide into upper stretch, took over command three-sixteenths out, knocked heads getting displaced inside the eighth pole before being shaken off in the final sixteenth and ran on clear for the place honors. GOODTHINGSTAKETIME (IRE) three when two wide through the first turn, settled under rating just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, advanced given a notch midway on the turn and took over command with five-sixteenths remaining, swung three then two wide for home coming under threat from flanking challengers, got displaced straightened away, tipped out to the three path as ALTEA came in to look DADDY IS A LEGEND in the eye at the three-sixteenths, couldn't match the top pair while keeping on for the show honors. ANDINA DEL SUR four then three wide through the first turn, raced three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs from home as ALTEA circled outside, continued three wide into upper stretch and failed to quicken through the stretch while stayinng on evenly for the last major share. HEAVENLY LOVE four then three wide through the opening bend, tracked the pace three wide from near the rear, came under urging tipped out five wide at the three-eighths following the move made by ALTEA, went four wide for home and made no headway through the stretch. GOING OUT brushed the off side stall at the start, raced under a firm hold tracking along the inside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and weakened. PUNKED (IRE) coaxed from the start, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside, came under pressure for the initial time nearing the midway point on the turn and was put to a drive in response, got displaced from command five-sixteenths from home, began to back away when forced to check off the heels of DADDY IS A LEGEND as that rival cut the corner directly in front, spun just off the inside for home and faltered in the drive.
