1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.46i) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 LAKE PLACID S.(GRADE II) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2 % divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake twice on the turf in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; such a race in 2006, 4 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf; or two races on the turf, 6 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweeps take on the dirt allowed 2 lbs.; three races, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered for dirt and turf). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading under review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 5, 2006 with 25 Nominations.

WAIT A WHILE moved to the outside in the early stages stalked the pace outside ART SHOW for five furlongs, closed the gap to challenge on the far turn, took charge in upper stretch, quickly opened a commanding lead in midstretch and drew away with authority while being kept to the task. LADY OF VENICE (FR) checked slightly and was taken in hand at the start, raced under a firm hold while between horses on the backstretch, trailed to the far turn while continuing well in hand, angled three wide entering the stretch and rallied mildly to best the others. DANCING BAND was taken in hand along the rail on the first turn, saved ground along the backstretch, raced within striking distance to the turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. ART SHOW set the pace along the rail to the turn and weakened from her early efforts. DIAMOND SPIRIT raced just off the pace from outside for seven furlongs, advanced four wide into the stretch and steadily tired thereafter.
