RUSHING FALL came under a firm hold shortly after the start and settled in closest aim of the leader just off the inside through the first turn and into the backstretch, remained patiently handled through to the far turn, got given a notch at the five-sixteenths, accelerated to issue a challenge and take command swinging just off the inside for home, straightened away to the rail put to hand urging and being shown the stick to the off side and edged clear under a drive to the finish to prevail comfortably at the end. CAPLA TEMPTRESS (IRE) brushed the near side stall at the start, settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, remained patiently handled in hand until put to light urging at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors while never threatening the winner. DADDY IS A LEGEND settled under rating two to three wide in mid pack, remained on hold until set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and kept on to secure the show honors safely over the rest. ANDINA DEL SUR broke out at the start and was corrected, raced three wide through the opening bend before settling just off the top pair three wide, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide at that station, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages. SIGNIFICANT FORM rated along the inside in mid pack, remained patiently handled until nearing the guarter pole, came under very brief coaxing before being taken in hand behind a pair of rivals just off the inside at the quarter pole, swung three wide straightened away and offered no serious response. GO NONI GO established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside through sensible splits, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths attempting to give her rivals the slip, had the field remain with her, got headed at the quarter pole and cut the corner into upper stretch, then faltered through to the finish. THEWAYIAM (FR) saved ground near the rear of the field, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cornered three wide into upper stretch, tipped out to the six path nearing the eighth pole before shying in under an off sided stick all the while coming up empty in the stretch run.
