DEAN'S KITTEN settled in hand four wide to track the leaders, ranged up to engage RANGER HEARTLEY with five-sixteenths to run, took over and drifted out into the stretch, edged clear and increased his advantage late. NORTHERN GIANT was well placed four wide, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, was carried out a bit leaving the second turn, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner through the final furlong. CONNEMARA hopped at the start, was unhurried into stride and settled along the inside, swung seven wide to make a late rally and finished willingly to earn the show. CHIEF COUNSEL settled near the tail of the field three deep, swung seven wide and improved position through the stretch, but found his best stride too late. VOW TO WAGER was away in good order, angled in and was forwardly placed three wide, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, but weakened from between horses and gave way.

LETSGETITONMON was unhurried and angled in to save ground at the tail of the field, swung to the outside to make a belated gain but was never a factor. OUTLAW MAN was jostled at the start and slow into stride, was rank to place and pulled to close the gap five wide, shifted in entering the second turn, steadied off heels near the three furlong marker, came up empty thereafter and dropped out. DOUBLES PARTNER was forwardly placed along the inside, got through to make a mild bid leaving the second turn but came up empty in the drive. RANGER HEARTLEY sped clear to set the pace off of the inside, was collared between horses with a quarter to run and gave way readily once headed.
