UNZIP ME sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, hopped slightly onto the main track crossing, kicked clear, bobbled a bit in deep stretch and held under a vigorous hand ride and a long hold late. CZECHERS had speed outside the winner then stalked just off the rail, closed the gap to that rival late and held second. GOTTA HAVE HER broke alertly but outward and bobbled some, dropped back between foes then chased outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted in a bit and finished with interest. ANNIHILATION steadied when crowded at the start, settled off the rail then angled in, came out leaving the hill and into the stretch and improved position. JEHAN broke a bit slowly, pulled her way along inside then between horses on the hill and lacked the needed rally. BURG BERG cut the corner at the right hand curve, chased outside then three deep on the hill and into the stretch and weakened. NADESHIKO angled in and stalked the pace inside to the stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
