ROCKET TWENTYONE, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter under light reserve while well off the inside in the opening stages, shifted inwards entering the bend, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command leaving midstretch and prevailed in time under firm left handed prompting. ESSENCE OF BUBBLES moved to the fore while shifting well off the inside in the opening quarter, dictated the pace on her own courage while angling to the rail entering the turn, was roused to extend her advantage entering upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. ANN OF THE DANCE, reserved in hand in the opening half, split foes racing through the bend while making some contact with DREAM PEGASUS near the quarter mile marker, angled out five wide in upper stretch and was going well late to prevail for a share while closing the gap on the top pair. VENETIAN SONATA, reserved in last along the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground on the bend while gradually gaining contention, shifted off the inside to split foes nearing midstretch and produced a belated response to close the gap on the leaders. ALWAYS HERE TOO, within striking distance early, tracked the leaders four deep between foes in the second flight in the opening half, continued in that path on the turn while being urged to challenge but couldn't produce the needed closing bid while finishing evenly in the last quarter. DREAM PEGASUS tracked the leaders five wide between foes in the second flight in the opening half, faded racing through the turn, was bumped leaving the quarter mile marker while being carried out six wide entering upper stretch and lacked a further response. YORONA tracked off the second flight along the inside in early stages, advanced inside foes to make a brief bid racing through the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. STRUCK IT LUCKY, held up off the first flight between foes in the opening stages while racing off the inside in the opening stages, shifted nearer to the inside entering the turn but steadily faded from striking distance nearing upper stretch.
