The winner to receive \$180,000 PLUS 50 KENTUCKY OAKS POINTS, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I race at One Mile or Over, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade II OR Grade III race at One Mile or Over, 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 70)

FASHION PLATE sped to the early lead, dueled inside then inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside or a bit off the rail and held on gamely under urging. STREAMING had speed three deep then stalked off the rail or outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and went on willingly outside the winner late but could not get by. ARETHUSA settled inside, split rivals on the second turn, came out in the stretch and finished well. TASTE LIKE CANDY had speed between foes then dueled outside the winner, stalked that one off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, loomed again nearing the stretch but weakened some in the final furlong. ARTEMIS a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SAINTLY JOAN chased inside then a bit off the rail on the first turn and backstretch, found the fence again into the second turn and did not rally. SUSHI EMPIRE chased outside a rival then off the rail, dropped back between horses into the stretch and weakened.
