KIMBEAR chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out three deep into the stretch, loomed behind the winner in midstretch, could not catch that one but was clearly second best. ARISTOCRATIC stalked outside a rival, bid three deep between horses into the turn. battled between foes leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted to the rail in the drive and bested the others. TAXMAN'S QUEST saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside past midway on the backstretch and into the turn, fell back along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SUTTON IMPACT sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled between horses into the turn then along the inside leaving the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
